

Clark County REMC Purdue Scholarship Program

Rules:

- Applicant must reside in the home of a parent or legal guardian who is a Clark County REMC member and receives electric service from the REMC. The membership application must be in the name of a parent or guardian at the time the scholarship is awarded.
- Applicant must be a high school senior who has been admitted to Purdue Polytechnic in New Albany for the 2019 fall semester.
- Applicant must attend Purdue as a full-time student (12 credit hours minimum).
- Scholarship is also open to the immediate family of any REMC employee or director that is a REMC member.
- A one page typewritten essay will be required in order to gain a greater insight of the applicant.

Application Process:

Five scholarships will be awarded at \$1,000 each. Applications will be available from Purdue, high school guidance counselor office, or from the REMC office. High schools that will be included are: Borden, Charlestown, Christian Academy of Indiana, Floyd Central, Henryville, Jeffersonville, New Albany, New Washington, Christian Academy, Providence, Rock Creek Christian, Scottsburg and Silver Creek. Home schooled students are eligible. Students of REMC employees are also eligible.

Return application to the Student Services Coordinator at Purdue by March 10, 2019.

Selection Process:

Purdue will make the selection based on SAT scores, class ranking, and the submitted essay. Winners will not necessarily have the highest SAT score or class ranking.

Recognition of scholarship recipients will be given at the REMC annual meeting, published in REMC publications and released to local papers.
